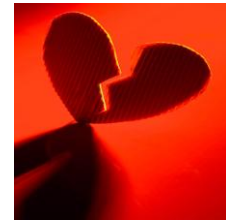


*Broken

In 2007, we saw the Hand of God move in miraculous ways. God opened doors for ministry in two new areas where we had never served. A ministry opportunity in the Philippines was an unexpected blessing for us. We experienced a great blessing from the people there as we found the children and adults alike were hungry and eager to receive the Word of God and have their lives changed by its power. The construction workers we encountered worked as a team with singleness of purpose. In the midst of great poverty and need, God showed Himself strong in many ways.

Our children's camp ministry to Africa continued in Kenya and was expanded to Ghana and Uganda. This year we were able to minister to approximately 1,000 children with 387 making a profession of faith in Christ as personal Savior. Some of these children live in Muslim households where Christ is not the center of the home. Please join us as we continue to pray for these new believers.

We were able to continue our work with orphan children in India. This year we visited a new home in south India where God is at work to provide for their needs on a daily basis.

In 2008, God continues to open doors of ministry opportunity around the world. We continue to receive requests for assistance from worthy ministries. God is working to bring these needs to our attention. We believe that He would have us respond to these needs by being His Hands and Feet. We at Broken Hearts Ministries are committed to doing all we can to help meet the needs of orphan children around the world as the Lord gives provision.
